

Frederick Street to Jubilee Terrace Toowong to Bardon

Safety improvement works

Main Roads is making improvements at various locations along Fredrick Street, Rouen Road, Boundary Street, MacGregor Terrace and Jubilee Terrace to improve safety for motorists and pedestrians.

The improvements we are delivering are:

- installing guardrail
- installing reflective road marker to clearly define lanes at night
- upgrading signage
- upgrading pedestrian access ramps.

Timing

Works are scheduled to commence in late March 2009 and are expected to be completed by early July 2009, weather permitting.

Works will take place Monday to Friday between 9am and 3pm and overnight between 7.30pm and 5am.

Construction impacts

Minor traffic delays may occur due to lane closures and reduced speed limits through the work site. Traffic controllers will be onsite to ensure safety for roadworkers, motorists and pedestrians.

Work vehicles will be fitted with reversing beepers as required by law and lighting equipment will be used.

Main Roads will make every effort to keep disruptions to a minimum and apologises for any inconvenience.

RoadTek will be carrying out these works on behalf of Main Roads.
